A company called ESP Play have been to assess our space and have agreed to make a plan and design a new play area for us. We are awaiting the design and an estimated cost. When the design is in, we will share it with all the classes and everyone will have an opportunity to vote for their favourite aspects. Once this is complete, we can decide what phase 2 etc. will be and how much we need to save!

Our fundraising ideas are still under development but you can be sure that they will be extraordinary!
